

To use FTP from DOS prompt

From a command prompt:

1. Type "ftp Domainname.com" (type in your domain name without the quotation marks) and hit enter.
2. You will be prompted for a username. Type "username" (your user name without the quotation marks) and hit enter.
3. You will be prompted for a password. Type "password" (type in your password without the quotation marks) and hit enter.
4. The prompt should now look like this: ftp>
5. To get a directory listing type "dir" (without the quotation marks) and hit enter.
6. To upload a file type "put" (without the quotation marks), a space, and the file path and name and hit enter.
7. To download a file type "get" (without the quotation marks), a space, and the file name and hit enter.
8. When finished type "bye" (without the quotation marks) and hit enter.
